OFFICIAL RULES OF THE

FISHIN' WITH ORLANDO BASS TOURNAMENT

The purpose of the Fishin' With Orlando BASS (Basic Apathy towards Submarining Skills) Tournament is to promote a greater awareness of basic submarine skills. All tournament participants are encouraged to submit, to the tournament directors, suggestions for additional big game "fish".

OFFICIAL RULES:

- 1) Fish must be caught first hand. Anglers may not claim fish caught by non participants or other anglers. Fish may be caught by two or more anglers. However, weights claimed will be divided equally between all involved in the catch.
- 2) Anyone caught throwing a fish back will have the weight equivalent to the catch deducted from their catch card.
- 3) Any tournament participant caught violating basic submarining skills will forfeit all recorded catches and start the tournament over.
- 4) All fish caught must be publically humiliated on the mess decks, at chow time. This humiliation must be witnessed by another angler and validated in writing on the catch card, or the catch does not count.

Hollywood shower	.5 lbs
Unflushed commode (urine only)	.5 lbs
Unflushed commode (combination)	.10 lbs
Sound silencing violation (BST/ULTRA QUIET)	.15 lbs
Skating out of stowing DC gear	.15 lbs
